- Trimani Wine Bar (Near Termini Station): One of Rome's oldest enotecas (since 1821) with a huge selection of Italian and international wines. Offers both casual glasses and bottles to take home.
 - **Try:** A super Tuscan wine with their excellent charcuterie board.
- Beppe e i Suoi Formaggi (Jewish Ghetto): A wine and cheese lover's paradise, serving artisanal cheeses from all over Italy. Focuses on natural wines and small producers.
 - **Try:** A glass of Frascati Superiore (a white from Lazio) with a selection of local cheeses.
